**Original work, Reviews, Case report, Case series & innovation and scientific educational models
For Ug, PG & professionals in fields of:**

CARDIOPULMONARY

Stroke prevention, aerobic training, fatigue, and respiratory care in Neurological conditions.

COMMUNITY

Disability, caregiver education, home modification, fall prevention, community reintegration

TECHNOLOGY

Virtual reality, robotics, artificial intelligence, wearable sensors, tele-rehabilitation

PEDIATRICS

Neurodevelopment, sensory integration, motor milestones, cerebral palsy

NUTRITION/SLEEP/ LIFESTYLE

Brain health, nerve function, cognition, fatigue, and neuroplasticity.

MUSCULOSKELETAL

Pain neuroscience, proprioception, balance, posture, neural mobility, gait

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Registration for the conference is mandatory for all presenters.
2. Each participant is permitted to present only one poster/presentation in a category.
3. The submitted poster must not reveal any identifying information such as participant names, institutional affiliations, logos, or other identity markers.
4. Presentations may include:
 - Original Research
 - Review Studies
 - RCTs
 - Case Report/Series
 - Innovations/Prototype Demonstrations: Teaching-learning models, Patient Education Model, rehabilitation devices, assistive technologies, digital health solutions, AI applications, Prototypes, and healthcare innovations
5. All submissions must be scientifically accurate, original, and free from plagiarism.
6. Ethical considerations and approval details (where applicable) must be clearly mentioned in the submission.
7. Any copyrighted material used in the poster must be appropriately acknowledged, and permissions must be disclosed wherever necessary.
8. Requests for a specific presentation date or time slot will not be entertained.

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GENERAL GUIDELINES

9. Poster Presentation Format:

- Presentation Time: **5 minutes**
- Discussion and Q&A: **2 minutes**

10. The presenting author will receive a certificate of presentation.

11. The decision of the scientific committee and judges shall be final and binding.

12. All E-posters must be submitted on or before **30th June 2026 – 11:59**

14. The allotted category and presentation code must be clearly mentioned on the poster.

Poster Submission Requirements

- File Format: PowerPoint (.PPT / .PPTX)
- Orientation: Landscape
- Recommended Size: 16:9 Widescreen Ratio
- Maximum File Size: 10 MB
- Font Style: Times New Roman
- Minimum Font Size: 24 pt
- Background: Plain white or light-colored background recommended.

Mandatory Sections in the Poster

1. Title

Include the full title of the study/presentation. Mention the allotted category and presentation code below the title.

2. Background and Need for the Study

- Brief introduction to the topic
- Existing problem or gap in knowledge/practice
- Rationale and significance of the study

3. Aim and Objectives

- Clearly state the aim & objectives of the study

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4. Methodology Include: Study design, Sample size, Population, Tools/Outcome measures used, Data analysis methods

5. Results

- Present key findings clearly and concisely . Use tables, charts, graphs, or figures where applicable

6. Discussion and Conclusion : Interpretation of findings, Significant observations ,Study limitations ,Concise conclusion

7. Clinical Relevance

Explain the potential implications of the findings on:

- Clinical practice
- Rehabilitation approaches, Patient care, Community health , Policy or interdisciplinary healthcare delivery

8. References

- Use a consistent referencing style (APA/Vancouver recommended)

GUIDELINES FOR INNOVATION AND MODEL CATEGORY PRESENTERS

Objective of the Category

- Undergraduate (UG) Students
- Postgraduate (PG) Students
- PhD Candidates

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GUIDELINES FOR INNOVATION AND MODEL CATEGORY PRESENTERS

Presentation Requirements

- Poster must clearly explain the problem, need, concept, methodology/design and expected impact.
- The model/prototype/demo must be safe, functional or visually demonstrable.
- Participants must mention power supply, table space, internet, screen, special setup or any other additional requirements in the registration form.
- Innovation should be original; borrowed images, tools, AI-generated content or external support must be acknowledged.
- Patient-related data, videos or photographs must be used only with consent and confidentiality.

- Practical Applicability

- Clarity of Presentation
- Impact on Healthcare Practice
